



Sport Premium Funding

2018-2019

The government is providing additional funding to schools to improve the provision of Physical Education (PE) and Sport in primary schools. The Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport provide this funding jointly.

During the academic year of 2018-2019 Burnside Academy will receive a total of £17400. This funding is to be spent on improving the provision of PE and Sport in schools.

At Burnside Academy the Sport Premium funding will be used to:

- Employ a full time sports apprentice to develop extra sporting activities before and after school and to support the PE lead during tournaments and competitions.
- Continue to participate in festivals and sporting competitions across the city as part of the Kepier Academy PE cluster group.
- Further CPD for staff - dance and gymnastics based on staff audit. This will enable staff to develop their confidence to teach these areas of PE at a higher level.
- Carry out a review of PE equipment for a phased replacement programme.
- To purchase seven I pads to allow staff to record evidence of learning taking place in PE and to allow children to evaluate their performance.
- Employ coaches to carry out workshops linked to specialised sporting activities.

All sporting participation and achievements will be celebrated through school assembly and the sporting display board.

As a result of our dedication to physical activity in 2017-2018 we were given the SILVER School Games Mark award for our commitment, engagement and delivery of competitive school sport in 2017-2018. In 2018-2019 our aim is to build on this success.
