



This is me! - Homework Project- Year 1

<p>Art:</p> <p>Draw, paint or create a portrait of yourself, this could be you now or when you were younger.</p> <p>Create a family portrait.</p> 	<p>D.T:</p> <p>Make a box of your own that you could keep special memories and significant items in.</p> 	<p>D.T:</p> <p>Research historical toys. Try to make your own e.g a kaleidoscope, a thaumatrope.</p> 	<p>Computing:</p> <p>Complete some research on the internet about your family history or about the local area where you live.</p> 
<p>History:</p> <p>Sequence pictures of your life e.g. from birth to now. How have you changed?</p> 	<p>Geography:</p> <p>Find a significant place on a map e.g. somewhere you used to go, your old house, somewhere you went on holiday.</p> 	<p>Science:</p> <p>Learn about the parts of your body (elbow, knee etc.). You could label a photograph or drawing of yourself.</p> 	<p>Writing:</p> <p>Make a book about yourself. You might want to draw pictures or write about your favourite things. You may want to put in photographs or drawings of special memories.</p>
