



## Sport Premium Funding

2020-2021

The government is providing additional funding to schools to improve the provision of Physical Education (PE) and Sport in primary schools. The Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport provide this funding jointly.

During the academic year of 2020-2021 Burnside Academy will receive a total of £17480. This funding is to be spent on improving the provision of PE and Sport in schools.

At Burnside Academy the Sport Premium funding will be used to:

- Continue to participate in festivals and sporting competitions across the city as part of the Kepier Academy PE cluster group. £2500
- Provide transport to and from sporting events across the city. £2000
- Purchase a PE scheme and provide CPD for staff to develop their confidence to teach PE at a higher level. £3000
- Provide transport for coastal schools sessions. £2000
- Purchase of PE equipment in line with the new scheme and continue a phased replacement programme. £4000
- Purchase interactive board for hall to facilitate delivery of PE scheme £2500
- Employ coaches to carry out workshops linked to specialised sporting activities. £1000
- Participate in additional sporting events. £1000

All sporting participation and achievements will be celebrated through school assembly and the sporting display board.

As a result of our dedication to physical activity in 2018-2019 we were given the SILVER School Games Mark award for our commitment, engagement and delivery of competitive school sport in 2018-2019. In 2020-2021 our aim is to build on this success.
