



Sport Premium Funding

2025 - 2026

The government is providing additional funding to schools to improve the provision of Physical Education (PE) and Sport in primary schools. The Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport provide this funding jointly.

During the academic year of 2025-2026 Burnside Academy will receive a total of £17,090. This funding is to be spent on improving the provision of PE and Sport in schools.

At Burnside Academy the Sport Premium funding will be used to:

- Purchase SLA to participate in festivals and sporting competitions across the city as part of the Kepier Academy PE cluster group. £2500
- Provide transport to and from sporting events across the city and wider where necessary. £2440
- Purchase and embed a PE scheme to strengthen staff confidence in delivering high-quality PE lessons. £150
- Purchase sport equipment in line with the new PE programme, and a phased replacement scheme for existing equipment where needed. £2000
- Purchase equipment to engage and involve all children during play and lunchtime sessions. £1000
- Provide additional swimming sessions for Year 5 pupils. £2000
- Participate in additional sporting events. £1000
- Participate in coastal schools. £4500
- Subsidised residential outdoor visits. £1000
- Provide after school sporting clubs. £500

As a result of our dedication to physical activity in 2024/2025 we were given the GOLD School Games Mark award for our commitment, engagement and delivery of competitive school sport. In 2025 - 2026 our aim is to build on this success.
