



Sport Premium Funding

2024 - 2025

The government is providing additional funding to schools to improve the provision of Physical Education (PE) and Sport in primary schools. The Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport provide this funding jointly.

During the academic year of 2024-2025 Burnside Academy will receive a total of £17130. This funding is to be spent on improving the provision of PE and Sport in schools.

At Burnside Academy the Sport Premium funding will be used to:

- Purchase SLA to participate in festivals and sporting competitions across the city as part of the Kepier Academy PE cluster group. £2400
- Purchase sport equipment for PE lessons and for children to use at break times to ensure increased levels of activity. £4000
- Employ coaches to carry out workshops linked to specialised sporting activities. £1000
- Provide additional swimming sessions for Year 5 pupils. £2000
- Participate in additional sporting events. £1000
- Participate in coastal schools. £4500
- Subsidised residential outdoor visits. £1000
- Provide after school sporting clubs. £1500
- All sporting participation and achievements will be celebrated through school assembly and the sporting display board. £100

As a result of our dedication to physical activity in 2023/2024 we were given the GOLD School Games Mark award for our commitment, engagement and delivery of competitive school sport. In 2024 - 2025 our aim is to build on this success.
