Nature of support
<p>The government offers funding to tackle inequalities between children on free school meals and their peers called the pupil premium. Pupil Premium funding supports pupils who are currently eligible for free school meals, or who have been eligible for free school meals at any point in the last six years.</p> <p><b>For the academic year 2020/21 our pupil premium funding was £103,840 which we allocated to the following areas:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Targeted intervention (in class, during afternoon sessions and after school) – delivered by Teachers and TAs</li> <li>• Early Language intervention</li> <li>• School liaison with CYPS/CAMHS to provide specialist support</li> <li>• Subsidised visit for Y6 pupils to Moorhouse Adventure Centre</li> <li>• Attendance monitoring</li> <li>• Educational Psychologist</li> <li>• Behaviour Support Team</li> <li>• Wellbeing CPD and support</li> <li>• LAC/ Early Help/CIN/CP</li> </ul>
